

Minimum Graduation Requirements

This program would not prepare a student for entrance into a major university but may prepare him/her for a community or junior college. We would expect students to have as many credits as possible at graduation, but this would be the absolute minimum. Students graduating with the minimum requirements are not eligible to graduate with honors.

Permission to graduate under the minimum high school program must be agreed to in writing and signed by the student, student's parent/guardian and the Head of School or Secondary Principal. Administrative discretion may be used to meet special circumstances.

English: 4 credits consisting of English I, II, III, & IV

Math: 3 credits consisting of Algebra I, and Geometry and one or more of the following: Algebra II, Pre-Calculus, Independent Study in Mathematics or AP Calculus AB.

Science: 2 credits consisting of Biology and a second BCS approved science course.

Social Studies: 2 1/2 credits: US History, and US Government (one-half credit). Final credit

may be World History or World Geography

Economics: 1/2 credit

Physical Education: 1 credit (No more than 2 Physical Education credits can count toward

graduation requirements.)

Speech: 1/2 credit Fine Arts: 1 credit

Bible: 4 credits or one for each year enrolled at BCS

Health: 1/2 credit (only required if student is enrolled @ BCS in year offered)

Additional credits: 3

Total credits: 22
